

Adult Horse Wellness:

An ounce of prevention is worth a pound of cure! Whether you have a horse at a boarding facility, your home, or are heading to the Olympics, our veterinarians can help to make a wellness routine that fits all your horses needs!

Here's a breakdown of what wellness/preventative care we recommend 

Vaccine/Wellness Care	How Often?	Which Horses Need It?
Oral Exam with possible Dental Float	At least once per year	All horses, especially the young and elderly
Fecal Egg Count	Twice per year; Fall and Spring	All horses. This allows us to know how often and with what product you should deworm your horse with.
EWT/West Nile Vaccine	Annually, best if given in the Spring	All horses. This covers mosquito borne illnesses and tetanus.
Rabies Vaccine	Annually	All horses
Flu/Rhino Vaccine	Every 6 months	All horses that travel, are at boarding barns, or meet other horses. This covers respiratory diseases that transmit horse to horse.
Strangles Vaccine	Annually	Some horses that are boarded or travel.
Botulism Vaccine	Annually	Horses that are fed off a round bale
Potomac Horse Fever Vaccine	Once or twice per year	Horses that are pastured near a stream or standing water or who head southeast for competition.
