GASTROSCOPE MONTH

At the Clinic:

Gastroscope -\$287 (regularly \$428) plus Sedation (approximately \$55-\$65). Your horse will need to be dropped off the day prior before 6 PM. Stabling for your horse's overnight stay will be complementary (regularly \$67), and we will manage their fasting preparations for the gastroscope exam.


On the Farm:

1 Horse: Gastroscope - \$343 (regularly \$428) *plus* Sedation (approximately \$55-\$65) and Farm Call (\$89-\$101 depending on your location).

2 or more horses at the same location: Gastroscope -\$287 each (regularly \$428) *plus* Sedation each (approximately \$55-\$65) and Farm Call (split if 2 or more owners). This requires the owner and barn to be responsible for the fasting preparations. If the horse isn't properly fasted, the client will still be responsible for the price of the procedure, sedation, and farm call.

The discounted gastroscope price will be honored for the first recheck/follow-up gastroscope. It is recommended to perform the recheck prior to finishing the medication regimen (typically 28 to 30 days following the initial gastroscope).
